Assembly Bill No. 2674 amended several provisions of the Ralph M. Brown Act (Section 54590 tense. of the Government code) effective January 1, 1987. The bill prohibits the Parks and Recreation Commission from taking action on any item which did not appear on the agenda, which was posted 72 hours prior to the Parks and Recreation Commission meeting. If the Commission action is necessary on subject matter which the public presents the matter should be presented in writing to the Director of Parks & Recreation for placement on the agenda by Tuesday noon, prior to the next Parks and Recreation Commission meeting.


