

**Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the City of Huntington Park  
Health and Education Commission  
held July 27, 2010**

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The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Chairman Cesar Zaldivar-Motts. Also in attendance were Housing and Community Development Manager Manuel Acosta, Senior Planner Albert Fontanez and Recording Secretary Corinna Luevano.

***MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING HELD ON JUNE 22, 2010:***

***PUBLIC APPEARANCES:***

Sylvia Alvarado, Director of Business Development, Clinica Medica San Miguel (CMSM), was present to address the Commission. Ms. Alvarado stated that CMSM is interested in participating in any Health and Education related events in the City. CMSM has been in the community for 30 years and has 16 clinics throughout the area with 5 locations in Huntington Park. They would like to be more active in providing education through the health fairs. Ms. Alvarado also stated that they could potentially supply the flu vaccine at the upcoming Senior Health Fair in Huntington Park.

***A. Discussion and/or action on a list of goals and objectives for the HEC in 2010:***

Staff informed the Commission that meetings for the All-America City Award have been cancelled until September.

**D. Discussion and/or action regarding the 2010 Census:**

The Commission requested staff to ask a representative from the Census Bureau to attend the next HEC meeting to provide an update.

The Commission requested a table at the National Night Out on August 3, 2010. In addition, the Commission asked that the HEC budget be placed on the next agenda for discussion. Lastly, the Commission directed staff to invite a representative from Congresswoman Lucile Roybal-Allard's office at the next meeting to discuss the Health Reform Bill.
