
All through my career as a public servant I have worked to improve the lives of working families, to expand access to affordable

Used Oil Collections Held in Huntington Park

Did you know that the used oil from one oil change can pollute one MILLION gallons of water? You can keep used oil out of our storm

drains by dropping off used oil and oil filters at our collection events from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Saturday, May 2 & Saturday, August 1.

By recycling your used oil filter, you will receive a free new filter!
Limit three per household.

Recycling your used motor oil is easy!

1. Do not spill any oil on the ground.
2. Put your used motor oil in a clean plastic container with a tight lid. Never store used oil in a container that once held chemicals, food, or beverages.
3. Do not mix the oil with anything else, such as antifreeze, solvent, or paint.
4. Take used motor oil to a service station or other location that collects used motor oil for recycling. (Source: EPA)
