1. UPDATE FROM CITY STAFF OF MEETINGS WITH LUCILLE ROYBAL-ALLARD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CONCERNING N/S PEDESTRIAN CROSSING
The City met with the school in December 2014 to discuss alternatives such as staggering school end time to alleviate congestion around the school. The school expressed that they still want a north/south crossing to the school. The City discussed moving Buses to Saturn Avenue only and designating Plaska Avenue for Student drop off, as well as the option of looking at staggered drop off and pick up times. The City would discuss with the school several options and report back findings/discussion.

3. PEDESTRIAN OVERHEAD "HAWK" SIGNAL INSTALLATION AT SANTA ANA STREET AND MADISON AVENUE

The City of South Gate as part of their Safe Route to School funding application received funding for an overhead pedestrian "HAWK" signal at the intersection of Santa Ana Street and Madison Avenue. A portion of the intersection is in the City of Huntington Park. The City of South Gate is requesting an encroachment permit to install the "HAWK".

1. ILLUMINATED INSTREET LIGHTS AT CROSSWALK REMOVAL TO BE REPLACES WITH FLASHING BEACON

TA consultant staff is preparing an assessment for the removal of instreet illuminated lights in crosswalks (inroad lighted crosswalks) to be replaced with

pedestrian flashing beacons at 9 crosswalk locations throughout the city. A count and study is currently being done at each location and will be presented at the April Traffic Authority Meeting.

- 8) Florence Avenue and Bissell Street*
- 9) State Street and Live Oak Street*

2. ASPIRE SCHOOLS


