1. UPDATE FROM CITY STAFF OF MEETINGS WITH LUCILLE ROYBAL-ALLARD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CONCERNING N/S PEDESTRIAN CROSSING
2. 58TH STREET AT PACIFIC BOULEVARD AND 57TH STREET AT PACIFIC BOULEVARD CROSSWALK ASSESSMENT: Traffic Authority Consultant Staff has completed their findings in response to a petition submitted by parent's part of the Aspire Public Schools. A list of short-term and long-term recommendations have been completed.

CROSSWALK ASSESSMENT AT HILL STREET AND STATE STREET: Traffic Authority Consultant Staff has received and reviewed a request from students at Huntington Park High School regarding a school project called Civic Action Project. The request was originally sent to Mayor Karina Macias. The students have asked the City to look into the possibility of installing a crosswalk on Hill Street and State Street.

3. MILES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL REQUEST: LAUSD has submitted a written request for the City to install Passenger Loading Only, 7:00AM – 4:00PM, School Days signs, on the East side of Miles Avenue, beginning after the end of the yellow painted curb at the intersection of Miles Avenue and Saturn Avenue, and extending North 185 feet.
4. SAN ANTONIO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL REQUEST: LAUSD has submitted a written request for the City to install Passenger Loading Only, 6:30AM – 9:00AM, 1:30PM – 4:00PM, School Days – 2 Hour Parking, 9:00AM – 1:30PM, School Days, on the West side of Plaska Avenue, beginning 61 feet South of the centerline of Randolph Street and Plaska Avenue, and extending South 318 feet. As well as to remove No Parking, Passenger Loading and Unloading, 7:00AM – 4:00PM, School Days Sign, on the West side of Plaska Avenue, 110 feet South of the centerline of Randolph Street and Plaska Avenue.
