- TA staff continues to update and keep concerned residents informed of progress.
 - TA staff has attempted to contact Nimitz Middle School, HP Elementary, and Aspire Academy Principals and District Representatives. So far, we have been able to make contact with Aspire Academy's principals and their district representative. We are waiting to hear from the other schools.
2. Traffic Safety Review at Gage Ave and Bissell St
 - Tube counts, peak hour intersection counts, and pedestrian counts have been scheduled.
 - TA staff is contacting concerned residents and updating them of progress.
 3. Red Curb Request on 6102 Marbrisa Avenue
 - TA staff contacted United Pacific Waste & Recycling Services to see if it is possible for resident to place trash bins on Randolph Street in front of her driveway instead of on Marbrisa Avenue to avoid having her trash bins moved. UPW staff stated that the drivers have a fixed route but will contact supervisor to see if it is possible to change the pickup location.


