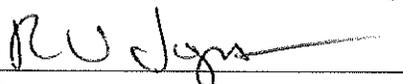

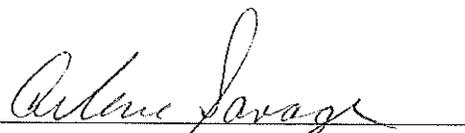
***Discussion on financial status of Community and Mission Hospitals and other related matters:***

Present to address the Commissioners was Dr. Ed Rubin of Community and Mission Hospitals 2623 Slauson Avenue, Huntington Park, California, 90255 and Chris Doan, General Legal Counsel for Community and Mission Hospitals.

Dr. Ed Rubin, President of Karyikeon stated that he has hired a new Purchasing Agent, as well as a new Financial Officer and Chief Executive Officer. Dr. Rubin reaffirmed again (as he had done so prior to acquiring the hospitals) his commitment to the Health and Education Commission and the City of Huntington Park, that he will NOT, in any way or form, reduce, alter or eliminate any current services currently being offered or utilized at either Community or Mission Hospital--"You have my word on that.". Commissioner Englanoff requested that Dr. Rubin email the Commissioners when any problems arise, so that the Commission will be informed. A discussion ensued regarding the financial status of the hospital.
