



City of Huntington Park Poster Contest Overview and Rules



The City of Huntington Park received grant funding to install 34 state-of-the-art solar powered beverage recycling containers on Pacific Blvd. This is part of the improvement/remodel project currently underway on Pacific Blvd. The recycling containers are connected to a trash receptacle, making it easy and convenient to recycle bottles or cans rather than throwing them in the trash.

The City of Huntington Park Public Works Department is sponsoring a poster contest to publicize this new way to recycle on Pacific Blvd. The posters that best illustrate the theme below (see #8) will be professionally reproduced and installed in protected frames on the side of the recycling bins. The City of Huntington Park may occasionally rotate or change the art at the discretion of the City Manager.

The poster contest is open to high school students and one winner will be selected from each grade level – 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grades. Each of these winning artists will receive a gift card from a local merchant with a minimum value of **\$100** and will be recognized for their achievement at a City Council meeting. Gift cards are donated from the General Employees Association and the Police Officers Association.

All entries must be received **no later than Thursday, February 16, 2017 at 5 p.m.** at the front desk/reception at City Hall located at 6550 Miles Avenue, Huntington Park, California. Entries must be a hard copy, delivered in person; no electronic or faxed entries will be permitted. Questions can be sent via email to postercontestqanda@hpca.gov. RULES:

1. Student must be attending a high school in Huntington Park or reside in Huntington Park.
2. All artwork must be original.
3. Contestants can enter only one poster.
4. Entries must be submitted on 8.5 X 11 white paper.
5. The name, address, phone number, high school and email of the artist must be written on the back **in pencil** – (this will prevent bleeding) do not use a pen or marker.
6. Do not sign the front of the artwork. Signed artwork will be disqualified. Selected artwork will be signed prior to professional reproduction.
7. Do not use any words on the artwork, except for: Huntington Park or HP
8. The artwork must represent or depict the following theme: ***“Recycling Beverage Containers is Easy and Good for HP”***
