



HUNTINGTON PARK ROAD TO RECOVERY

A Phased Approach to Reopen Safely

California, counties, local governments may have their independent guidelines. Please adhere to the following if your business is within Huntington Park, California. This document provides goalposts for reopening safely.

Five-Stage Reopening Process Based On Risk

STAGE 1

Safety and Preparedness

- Safer at Home Order (still in place) - **Essential business only**
- Planning and Recovery (in the process)

STAGE 2

Begins
June 5th

Lower-Risk Workplaces (Ensure distancing and infection control for all categories.)

- **Recreation, Entertainment, and Learning**
- **Shopping, Restaurants, and Personal Care**
- **Car Dealership Showrooms** - Modifications to ensure distancing and infection control
- **Essential Health Services**
- **Outdoor recreation and libraries (curbside pick-up only)**
- **Churches** congregants limited to less than 25% of the building's occupancy, or a maximum of 100 people, whichever is lower.

STAGE 3

Higher-Risk Workplace

- Higher-risk businesses (nail salons, body art/tattoo shops, massage, bars/nightclubs, gyms)
- Movie theatres and bowling alleys
- K-12 Schools
- Colleges and universities

STAGE 4

Large Higher-Risk Workplace

- Higher-risk businesses (entertainment venues)
- Sporting and spectator events

Five Key areas to focus on before reopening a business

1. Workplace policies and practices to protect employee health
2. Measure to ensure physical distancing
3. Measure to ensure infection control
4. Communication with employees and the public
5. Measure to ensure equitable access to critical services
