#### B. PREVIOUS ITEMS

1. All residents/business owners were notified via phone of the Traffic Authority (TA) decisions regarding their agenda item/request from the November 1, 2018 meeting.

#### C. NEW ITEMS

1. 4079 Santa Ana Street. Request for 20-min Green Curb.
2. 6868 Benson Street. Request for Stop Sign.
3. Alleys exiting onto Florence Avenue - Alleys between Marbrisa Avenue / Albany Street & Albany Street / Alameda Street. Request for Traffic Mirrors.

#### D. UPDATES

1. 6035 Pacific Boulevard. Request for reinstatement of an uncontrolled crosswalk on Pacific Boulevard between Belgrave Avenue and Randolph Street.
  - The application was denied and the applicant was informed that the location was determined to be unsafe for pedestrian crossing in a detailed study prepared before the crosswalk was removed.
2. 2438 E. 55th Street. Request for 30-min Green Curb.
  - The application was tentatively denied and the applicant was informed of the TA decision.
  - The Board asked the applicant to follow up his request with an explanation to justify why the additional yellow/green zone is needed and why the on-site parking area east of the building cannot be used for

- loading/unloading.
  - The applicant has been contacted and asked to follow up.
- 3. 6613 Plaska Avenue. Request to add speed cushions to reduce speeding. The application was denied and signage enhancement, as well as routine enforcement, was recommended.
  - The applicant contacted the City Clerk to file an appeal to City Council.
- 4. Request to revise hours of Permit Parking at the City Hall parking lot located at 6550 Miles Avenue
  - The Traffic Engineer submitted designs of signs with towed-away provision and posting locations for TA to consider.
  - The Traffic Engineer is to prepare a work order for the Public Works Director to review.
- 5. Aspire Pacific Academy, 2565 E. 58th Street. Request to make alley south of the school into a one-way alley.
  - The school administrators have been contacted and informed of the TA decision denying their request.
  - Work Order No. 18-00830 for four traffic signs to be posted at the south alley was completed.
- 6. Vehicle and pedestrian traffic concerns at Linda Esperanza Marquez High School, 6361 Cottage Street. Updated report.
  - The Traffic Engineer submitted a "Service Request" to LA County Department of Public Works to review and address the concerns.
  - The Traffic Engineer submitted draft plans to implement no parking and no U-turn on Cottage Avenue near the entrance to the school.
  - The City Manager to discuss with City Council.

#### **E. OPEN DISCUSSION**

1. 3075 Randolph Street. Request to review the yield sign on the northwest corner of State Street and Randolph Street and replace it with a stop sign. The issue is drivers are not yielding.
2. Parking T Policy
  - The Traffic Engineer to update the Parking T Policy to include requirement of obtaining 75% of signatures from affected residents.
3. Alley Ordinance
  - No Parking at City alleys. Vehicles to be towed per municipal ordinance. The Traffic Engineer drafted mailer with signage to be sent to residents with utility notices notifying ordinance 15 days in advance.
  - The Public Works Director to assess the cost and locations to post.
  - The Traffic Engineer prepared a work order and submitted it to the Public Works Director for review.
4. Driveway Ordinance to allow citation for partial blocking
  - The Police Chief to draft and get approval by City Council.
