| 7 | WHEREAS, the latest estimate indicates the population of the City of Huntington Park (the "City") to be 64,607; and |
| 8 | WHEREAS, the City remains in the same population grouping set forth in California Government Code section 36516 as a result of the latest estimate; and |

| 10 | WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 36516(c), provides that City Council salaries may be increased by five percent (5%) per calendar year from the operative date of the last salary adjustment. |

| 13 | WHEREAS, the operative date of the last salary adjustment was March 20, 2003. |
| 14 | NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON PARK DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: |

| 16 | SECTION 1. Section 2-1.102 of the Huntington Park Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows: |

| 20 | <u>SECTION 2</u> . Section 2-1.103 of the Huntington Park Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows: |

| 22 | "Section 2-1.103. Compensation. |
| 23 | Each member of the Council shall receive as salary the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Twenty Eight and 65/100ths (\$1,228.65) dollars per month, in accordance with the provisions of the Government Code of the State, which salary shall be payable on or after March 20, 2007." |

| 26 | SECTION 3. Except as amended above, Title 2, Chapter 1 of the Huntington Park |
| 27 | Municipal Code shall remain in full force and effect. |

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify as to the passage of this Ordinance.
